The University Honors Program at The Catholic University of America offers a challenging and inspiring liberal arts program to motivated students with outstanding academic promise. ### *Selection Process*

Students wishing to join the University Honors Program after they begin study at the Catholic University of America must first meet the required 3.5 minimum GPA. Exceptional students may be accepted based on first-semester midterm grades, but most students should expect to apply after a full semester of study. Prospective Honors students must complete the following application and an interview with the director or assistant director. Eligible students must be of freshman or sophomore standing. **Please note that a 3.5 GPA does NOT guarantee admission to the Honors Program, nor does the completion of this application.**
